Following the academic program in Korea, students will travel to Tokyo, Japan, to experience one of Asia's leading academic and cultural hubs. The program includes special lectures delivered by Waseda University, along with cultural and experiential activities that allow students to explore Japanese society, history, and everyday life from a local perspective.</p> <p>In addition to academic sessions, students will participate in a variety of activities such as a campus tour with Waseda student buddies, cultural</p>	

		<p>excursions to nearby cities including Kamakura, and visits to iconic destinations like Sanrio Puroland or Tokyo Disneyland. You must accept both</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The EduRec offer and • host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme. <p>✓ Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>✓ Applying on EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>

8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping requests are subject to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following:</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. 10	Visa Application	<p>Students from countries or regions where Korea has signed a Visa waiver agreement may enter Korea without a visa for the winter programme. Singaporeans are not required to obtain a visa.</p> <p>Students from other countries not listed in the visa exemption list must apply for a short-term study visa (D-2-8) on their own. The list of countries with visa exemptions is available at the Korean Embassy website.</p> <p>Note: It is student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangements for their summer programme. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for visa as early as possible as obtaining a visa can be time consuming.</p>

12	Student Insurance	<p>NUS Student Travel Insurance is provided for your participation in this programme.
