To enjoy the discounted price of USD\$1,600, please ensure that you submit your application on EduRec, so that GRO can make the necessary nominations.</p> <p><b>Please submit your EduRec application by 5 May 2020</b>, so that NUS can nominate you on time for the 15 May 2020 application deadline.</p>
8	<b>Module Mapping</b>	<p>You can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. <a href="#">Click here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum of 2 modules (up to 10 MCs) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August).</li> <li>• Maximum of 1 module (up to 5 MCs) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January).</li> </ul> <p>Total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the <a href="#">Registrar's Office website</a>.</p>
