PROGRAMME DETAILS		
4	Academic Content	<p>The 4-week programme provides opportunities for students to travel through different cities and stay at various Tec de Monterrey campuses. Besides taking courses, it includes field trips to companies and industries, and experiential learning components. Students can choose from 4 different programmes which offer 2 courses each. This is equivalent to 6 credits or 10 ECTS.</p> <p>(Please note: Students have to complete the course mapping process in NUS to seek approval for awarding of units. Refer to Item 8 for more details.)</p> <p>Programme choices:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Global Business 2. Mexican Cultural, Heritage and Social Challenges 3. Regional Economics 4. 5	Eligibility Requirements	NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details.
6	Accommodation	Housing is provided under the programme fees. However, the type of housing could vary from city to city.
7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply via EduRec and the host university's website <u>concurrently</u>.</p> <p>To enjoy tuition fee waiver for exchange students, please submit your application on EduRec by 1 May 2025, so that NUS Global can nominate you for the programme.</p> <p>Please apply with Tec de Monterrey by 16 May 2025 (programme application deadline).</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>You can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping. Also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum of 2 courses (up to 10 units) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August). • Maximum of 1 course (up to 5 units) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January). • Total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Registrar's Office website.

11	Student Insurance	<p>Insurance coverage for official NUS trips is provided for your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Please ensure that you have a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Canada. Review the insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs. Students are strongly encouraged to purchase supplemental travel insurance to ensure they are adequately covered during their time abroad.</p>
