| 4 | Academic Content | <p>The Ljubljana Summer School (LSS) is open to bachelor's and master's students, graduates, and young professionals seeking to gain new knowledge in specific fields. Courses are accredited with 6 ECTS credits and 7 ECTS credits.</p> <p>It is possible to enrol for 1 or 2 courses (one in the morning and one in the afternoon).</p> <p>Please refer to the course information website for more details.</p> |
| 5 | Eligibility Requirements | <p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details. Applications and selections are subject to review by the host university.</p> <p>Applicants should also note that certain courses may have prerequisites. Bachelor's students in their final year may register for Master's courses.</p> |
| 6 | Accommodation | <p>Participants of the LSS can register for the optional hospitality package. To book this package, you must select this option in the programme application form (Step 3 - Fees).</p> <p>The hospitality package includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accommodation in hostel DIC with self-service breakfast from 5 to 23 July 2026; • Lunch in the cafeteria next to the School of Economics and Business (daily from Monday to Friday, except weekends). <p>For further details, please refer to: https://shortprogrammes.ef.uni-lj.si/short_programmes/ljubljana_summer_school/hospitality_package/.</p> <p>If you do not wish to register for the hospitality package, as LSS does not have any special arrangements with private providers, you should find accommodation on your own. Breakfast and lunch are excluded in this case as well. You can have lunch in the same cafeteria next to the School of Economics and Business and pay directly at the cashier.</p> |
| 7 | Application Procedure | <p>Apply to NUS via EduRec and to LSS via their website concurrently.</p> <p>Application documents to be submitted to LSS can be found at: https://shortprogrammes.ef.uni-lj.si/short_programmes/ljubljana_summer_school/application_process/.</p> <p>For proof of English as the medium of instruction at NUS, you may self-generate a Student Status Letter with additional remarks on medium of instruction from EduRec following the instructions here: https://www.nus.edu.sg/registrar/student-records/certification-and-status-letters.</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> |

Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition.
