10	Visa Application	<p>All non-Thai nationals must submit the Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) online (https://tdac.immigration.go.th/) within three days prior to arrival in Thailand. You will receive an acknowledgement e-mail upon successful submission of the TDAC which should be presented to the immigration officer at the immigration counter.</p> <p>Please note that you are responsible for obtaining a valid visa before making any travel arrangements for your summer programme. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for visa as early as possible, as obtaining a visa might be time consuming.</p>
11	Travel Advisories	<p>Visit the MFA website for travel advisories on various countries from the Singapore government.</p>
12	Student Insurance	<p>NUS Student Travel Insurance is provided for your participation in this programme.
