| 6 | Application Procedure | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Interested students should apply for the programme on EduRec by Sun, 22 Feb 2026, for GRO's nomination to PSU. 2. GRO will submit nominations to PSU. 3. PSU will send an application to successful candidates, who must complete the application by Fri, 6 Mar 2026. 4. You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university's offer to confirm your participation in this programme. <p>You may proceed with course mapping and applying for financial aid after accepting the offer on EduRec.</p> <p>We require all NUS students going on NUS endorsed summer programmes to apply via EduRec. Besides allowing you to submit course mapping and apply for financial aid, this allows NUS to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. Additionally, NUS can also provide supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p> |

Course mapping requests are subjected to approval from the Faculties. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
