Students may apply for module mapping and transfer a maximum of eight (8) MCs (this is applicable only to electronic summer programmes 2021). Please note that some Schools or Faculties (including School of Computing) will not approve module mapping for remote or online courses. Please check with your home School or Faculty Dean's Office to determine if module mapping can be approved for remote/online courses before applying to the partner university

3	Academic Content	<p>The 2021 National Cheng Kung University (NCKU) International Summer School features the theme of "Sustainable Environment, Myth or Reality?". It has 9 sessions with each session covering a specific sustainable development goal (SDG) as established by the United Nations (UN).</p> <p>Other than the core course, there are also field trips to related local infrastructures/industries to connect the SDGs to local issues in Taiwan. Students can also choose the optional Exploring Tainan course to learn more</p>			

		<p>about the city.</p> <p>The core course bears 2 NCKU credits while the optional Exploring Tainan course is worth 0.5 NCKU credits.</p> <p>All courses are taught in English.</p>
