Exeter College welcome scholarship applications from suitably qualified candidates who are currently enrolled in full-time education with a minimum GPA of 3.6/4 or equivalent. To be considered for a scholarship you must first be in receipt of an offer to participate in the Programme. If programmes are hybrid, only on-site participation would qualify a student for financial aid. 6	Application Procedure at Host Institution	<p>The Exeter Summer Programme operates a rolling admissions process, so early application is strongly recommended.</p> <p>To be considered for admission, you will need to complete (1) an application form, (2) provide the supporting documents listed on the 'Entry Requirements' section and (3) pay a £60 administration fee. You will normally receive an admission decision within a week of submitting a complete application.</p> <p>Please find application form: https://www.exeter.ox.ac.uk/summer-programmes/ecsp/application/.</p>
7	Application Procedure at NUS	<p>Please apply on EduRec and at Host Institution concurrently.</p> <p>Please apply through NUS EduRec System if you want to do module mapping and to apply for financial aid. Applying through EduRec will allow GRO to</p>

		contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen). Read the step-by-step guide which we have prepared for you on GRO's web .
8	Module Mapping	<p>Exeter College does not operate a credit system and ultimately the calculation of credit will be decided by your Dean's office at NUS.</p> <p>You can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p> <p>For clarification, students may contact the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department.</p> <p>Module mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties.</p>
9	Transcript	<p>Students who successfully complete the Exeter Summer Programme will receive a transcript showing two grades, one for each lecture course, expressed as a grade-% and a letter equivalent, together with grading guidance notes.</p> <p>Your final lecture course grades will comprise:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Written Exams. One 3hr exam per lecture course (2) Research Essay. One 3,000-word essay per lecture course. (3) Participation and Attendance. <p>You must successfully complete each of these three elements in order to pass your courses.</p> <p>Exeter College does not operate a credit system and ultimately the calculation of credit will be decided by your Dean's office in NUS. As a guide, courses usually receive 3-4 US credits or 7.5 ECTS credits.</p>
