4	<b>Academic Content</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• AI</li> <li>• Machine Learning</li> <li>• Data Science</li> <li>• Economics</li> <li>• Finance</li> </ul> <p>The programme focuses on applied quantitative and analytical training across Data Science &amp; AI and Economics &amp; Finance. Our academic offering includes twelve courses: Mathematical Methods, Statistical Methods, Causal Data Science, Econometrics, Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence, alongside Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Network Economics, Complexity Economics, Quantitative Finance and Financial Markets.</p> <p>You choose one course per session. Each course runs for two weeks and consists of two connected one-week modules.</p> <p><b>AND</b></p> <p><b>Hackathon projects</b>        Hackathon Projects are intensive, team-based projects where you apply the tools and methods taught in your lectures and classes to real data and real questions... Each course consists of two self-contained weekly modules. 6	<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>The CUNJC Summer School is hosted at Selwyn College, one of the constituent colleges of the University of Cambridge. 7	<b>Application Procedure at NUS</b>	<p>Please apply through the NUS Education Records System - Global Education (<a href="#">EduRec-GE</a>) first if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial</p>

		<p>aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while overseas.</p> <p>With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide we prepared for you on <a href="#">GRO's website</a>.</p> <p>You should also concurrently apply to the host university once you have applied to NUS Edu-Rec.</p>

9	<b>Confirmation of participation</b>	To confirm your participation in this Programme, you must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.
10	<b>Course Mapping</b>	<p><b>All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.</b></p> <p>If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.</p>
11	<b>Transcript</b>	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address in the online registration portal so the host can send your transcript to you after the summer programme.</p> <p>Please <b>do not</b> request that your transcript be mailed to the NUS Global Relations Office (GRO). GRO is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

12	<b>Visa Application</b>	<p>From 25 February 2026, most travellers who previously entered the UK visa free must apply for an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) before travel. An ETA allows short-term study of up to six months but does not guarantee entry, as all students must still pass UK border control. Students studying in the UK for less than six months (e.g. one semester; short-term programmes) will need an ETA if travelling on a Singapore passport.
