7	Application Procedure	Apply via the host university's website and EduRec concurrently . You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.
8	Course Mapping	<p>If you are interested in obtaining credit, you can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Note that all mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties. Please also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each summer programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each winter programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools. • Of the units approved for mapping, a total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to NUS Special Term fees.
