5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see NUS Global website for details.</p> <p>According to Stanford, to be eligible to apply, students must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be selected by their home institution. • Have a minimum of 3.0 GPA (Meaning a CAP score of 3.75) • Be at least 18 years of age by the start of the program. • Have graduated from high school, secondary school, or an equivalent. • Have successfully completed at least one term of college or university courses following graduation from high school prior to applying. (Students who have already graduated from college or university are also eligible.) • Be able to verify fluency in the English language, using one of the methods described in the English Language Proficiency section on the International Students page. (NUS has a waiver for this requirement, but students can upload test results if they want to.) <p>For more information about IHP, please email summerhonors@stanford.edu.</p>

This fee is required for all students, regardless of whether or not you enroll in Stanford Cardinal Care or have private insurance.</p>
