6	<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>On-campus housing is available to visiting Yale Summer Session students. 7	<b>Application Procedure</b>	<p>Please apply to EduRec <u>first</u> that way GRO can provide you with the PIN needed to have the application fee waived.</p> <p><b>Please write to Jacob O’Quinn (<a href="mailto:jacob@nus.edu.sg">jacob@nus.edu.sg</a>) from NUS Global Relations Office once you have submitted your application on EduRec that way he can pass you the application waiver PIN.</b></p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p><b>The following materials are required for visiting international student applications:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Online Application</li> <li>2. University Transcript (in English): with Fall 2022 grades. If your fall grades are not available, then you must submit the equivalent of your high school transcript</li> <li>3. Proof of English Proficiency: required for students taking Yale courses.
