4	Academic Content	<p>Summer Session courses are highly accelerated and most meet every day; we want you to plan your schedule and time accordingly. We strongly recommend students enroll in no more than 8 credits per 6-week session and no more than 3 credits per 3-week session.</p> <p>Please keep in mind that students who need an I-20 (visa form) from UHM-Outreach College, they will need to register for 6 credit hours (undergraduate students) or 4 credit hours (graduate students) of classes and at least one class must have in-person instruction.</p> <p>A preview of Summer 2025 courses will be available in early December 2024, and will include a tentative list of classes and whether they are being planned with in-person or online instruction. UHM’s full schedule is expected to be available online on by early February 2025 and this schedule will indicate which courses are expected to be offered in-person or online.</p> <p>For additional resources, you can view course descriptions and prerequisite requirements from the UH Mānoa Catalog. The catalog is a comprehensive guide to UH Mānoa programs, course offerings, services, tuition, financial aid, faculty, facilities, academic policies, and other information of general importance to UH Mānoa students.</p> <p>Summer courses from UH’s Outreach College often have varied start and end dates with unique deadlines for registration, withdrawals, and refunds. 8	Course Mapping	<p>You can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping. Also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum of 2 courses (up to 10 units) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August). • Maximum of 1 course (up to 5 units) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January). • Total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Registrar's Office website.
