Click <a href="#">here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note that students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. 10	<b>Visa Application</b>	<p>Refer to the Vietnam embassy website for visa requirements: <a href="https://evisa.gov.vn/">https://evisa.gov.vn/</a></p> <p>Singaporeans who wish to enter Vietnam should refer to the website of the Vietnam Embassy in Singapore for information on entry requirements. Generally, Singapore Passport Holders do not require a visa to enter Vietnam and can remain up to 30 days per entry. Please note that the approval for entry into Vietnam, is ultimately at the assessment and discretion of the Vietnam Immigration authorities. Please apply as soon as you receive confirmation on joining the programme.</p> <p>Please note that you are responsible for obtaining a valid visa before making any travel arrangements for your summer programme. Students are encouraged to prepare for and apply for visa as early as possible, as obtaining a visa might be time consuming.</p>
