C. Academic Calendar	<p>Semester 1 (Fall term): Mid February to Late June Semester 2 (Winter term): Mid July to Late November http://www.anu.edu.au/directories/university-calendar</p>
D. Exchange Duration	One semester
E. Course Load	<p>Students need to study a full-course load while on exchange at ANU. A full course in ANU is 24 ANU units per semester (usually 4 courses at 6 units each). Students can apply to undertake a reduced study load of 18 units (equivalent to 3 courses) with the permission of their home faculty. Kindly note that the maximum workload at ANU is 24 units per semester.</p> <p>ANU’s teaching system is a combination of lectures, tutorials and laboratory classes. The amount of time students spend in classes will vary depending on the course. F. Accommodation	<p>On-campus housing is guaranteed for exchange students who apply for accommodation by the relevant deadlines. https://study.anu.edu.au/accommodation</p> <p>Please refer to the information provided by ANU for latest updates regarding housing availability.</p>
G. Visa	<p>Once you have purchased the Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC), your host university will issue an Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE), which is required for your Australian Student Visa Application.</p> <p>All exchange students must obtain an Australian Non Award Student Visa (sub-class 500) before arriving in Australia.</p> <p>Students are advised to apply for the necessary visa immediately after they received the official offer letter/email from their host university. This is to ensure that you can obtain your visa in time before the start of your exchange term. <p>H. Insurance</p>	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university’s Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/.</p> <p>All international students studying in Australia are required to purchase an approved Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) policy. OSHC is a condition of the Overseas Student Visa issued by the Australian Immigration authorities. The cost is approximately A\$350 for 6 months. Students can purchase OSHC through your host university.</p> <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Australia. Please review the insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs. Students can purchase additional health and/or travel insurance from their preferred agent.</p>
