## Information for Students on Exchange

B. Country	Canada
C. Academic Calendar	Winter session - first term: September – December Winter session - second term: January – April <a href="https://www.uvic.ca/calendar/dates/">https://www.uvic.ca/calendar/dates/</a>
D. Exchange Duration	One semester
E. Course Load	4.5 - 7.5 credits per term (approx. 3-5 courses). Each single-term course at UVic is typically worth 1.5 units, which is equal to 6 ECTS credits.
F. Accommodation	Limited space for on-campus housing, so apply as soon as possible. The dormitory rooms include a mandatory meal plan. The Cluster units include private bedroom with shared kitchen and living room. You can begin your application after you have been accepted by UVic and received your UVic Student number.  There are many different types of accommodations in Victoria to choose from. While waiting to secure on-campus housing, students should also source for off-campus housing options:  https://www.uvic.ca/international-experiences/living-in-victoria/housing-transportation/index.php#ipn-off-campus-housing  Alternatively, you may consider UVic Homestay, a program which offers students an opportunity to stay with a local family. G. Visa	Exchange students who study for one semester only (less than 6 months) are not required to apply for a study permit. However, depending on your country of citizenship, you may have to apply for an <a href="https://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp">eTA</a> OR a <a href="https://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/visas.asp">visitor visa</a> . H. Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance.
