ii) Curriculum Structure	Exchange students are required to read 6-15 credits at Fudan University for one semester (equivalent to 2-8 courses).
iii) Entry Requirements	 non-Chinese nationality preferred; Chinese national applicants are accepted but there is no provision of on-campus housing; be enrolled at the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a full-time student; have completed at least two semesters of study before embarking on the exchange programme; have a sound academic record, i.e. minimum GPA of 3.0, and should not have any grade below grade 'C' (grade point of 2.0) in any course; have sufficient financial means to cover the necessary expenses for the duration of the SEP (ranging from \$\$5,000 to \$\$15,000 per semester, subject to the country and local conditions at the overseas partner university during the period of exchange). When applying for your student visa, a number of countries may demand documentary proof of your financial status; obtain the Faculty's approval for the SEP; satisfy partner university and host country entry requirements; and check with the issuer of any scholarship he or she is receiving to ensure there are no restrictions involving overseas study (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education).
iv) Language Proficiency Requirements	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (limited English courses). NUS students with Chinese language background are exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency requirements to read Chinese-taught courses at Fudan University.

D. Accommodations

i) University Accommodation

Exchange students are housed at the International Students Dormitory located northwest of the Fudan campus. There are single and double rooms available. There is a 24-hour reception desk available at the lobby, with a mini-supermarket and meeting place. The gymnasium and students' dining halls are nearby. Students who are staying for an entire academic year are eligible for accommodation on campus during semester breaks. Accommodation fees will be pro-rated.

On-campus accommodation is very limited and on first come first served policy, students are reminded to check the booking period at the following website and apply for accommodation early.

E. Visa

Consular/Visa Regulation

Exchange students in China are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).

You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202) once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme. Exchange students are required to apply for the student visa in person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.

F. Safety, Health & Medical Insurance

Health/Medical Insurance

All full-time NUS students are covered under the university's Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university's student insurance scheme, please refer to

International students at Fudan University are required to purchase mandatory medical insurance according to regulations issued by Chinese Ministry of Education. The cost is RMB400 per semester.

Students staying in mainland China for more than 180 days must complete medical examination after enrolment at Fudan. Medical examination costs RMB660 and Resident Permit costs RMB400.

To have a physical examination after enrolment at Fudan is recommended because the verification of home physical examination record will probably fail due to different physical examination system. Exchange students are also required to go for medical examination at Fudan University upon enrolment. The medical examination cost is RMB660.
