ii) Curriculum Structure	Exchange students are expected to take at least 3 courses each semester. Course credits range from 2 to 4 NJU credits. One NJU credit equals to 16 hours of study.
iii) Entry Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • non-Chinese nationality (including Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macao passport holders); • be enrolled at the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a full-time student; • have completed at least two semesters of study before embarking on the exchange programme; • have a sound academic record, i.e. minimum GPA of 3.0, and should not have any grade below grade 'C' (grade point of 2.0) in any course; • have sufficient financial means to cover the necessary expenses for the duration of the SEP (ranging from S\$5,000 to S\$15,000 per semester, subject to the country and local conditions at the overseas Partner University during the period of exchange). When applying for your student visa, a number of countries may demand documentary proof of your financial status; • obtain the Faculty's approval for the SEP; • satisfy partner university and host country entry requirements; and • check with the issuer of any scholarship he or she is receiving to ensure there are no restrictions involving overseas study (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education).
iv) Language Proficiency Requirements	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (with limited English-taught courses). NUS students with Chinese language background may be exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency requirements to read Chinese-taught courses at Nanjing University.

Consular/Visa Regulation	<p>Exchange students in China are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).</p> <p>You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202) once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme. <p>F. Safety, Health & Medical Insurance</p>	
<p>Health/Medical Insurance</p>	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university’s Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university’s student insurance scheme, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/.</p> <p>Incoming international students to Nanjing University are highly recommended to purchase insurance in their home countries, which should cover the exchange duration. Exchange students should bring along the original insurance documents to Nanjing University.</p> <p>International Exchange Students must have comprehensive health insurance valid in China for enrolment as a full-time student at NJU. Since many insurance policies purchased outside China require substantial co-payments, have caps or exclude many illnesses, all incoming students should purchase a student health insurance when they register at NJU.
