ii) Curriculum Structure	The minimum credits required at Shanghai Jiao Tong University is 12 credits. Average full-load credits per semester is 20 - 25 credits (1 credit = 15-16 class hours).	
iii) Entry Requirements	 non-Chinese nationality (including Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macao passport holders); be enrolled at the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a full-time student; have completed at least two semesters of study before embarking on the exchange programme; have a sound academic record, i.e. minimum CAP of 3.0, and should not have any grade below grade 'C' (grade point of 2.0) in any module; have sufficient financial means to cover the necessary expenses for the duration of the SEP (ranging from \$\$5,000 to \$\$15,000 per semester, subject to the country and local conditions at the overseas Partner University during the period of exchange). When applying for your student visa, a number of countries may demand documentary proof of your financial status; obtain the Faculty's approval for the SEP; satisfy partner institution and host country entry requirements; and check with the issuer of any scholarship he or she is receiving to ensure there are no restrictions involving overseas study (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education). 	
iv) Language Proficiency Requirements	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (limited English courses). NUS students with Chinese language background are exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency	



	requirements to read Chinese-taught courses at Shanghai Jiao Tong University.
	Language of instruction at the UM-SJTU Joint Institute is English and welcomes exchange students from SJTU partner universities.

	Please note that SJTU School of Electronic Information and Electrical Engineering (SEIEE) courses are not open to exchange students. SEIEE includes seven major academic disciplines, including Electrical Engineering, Control Science and Engineering, Computer Science and Technology, Information and Communication Engineering, Electronic Science and Technology, Instrument Science and Technology, and software engineering. D. Accommodation	
i) University Accommodation	Both Xuhui campus and Minhang campus provide on-campus dormitories. Students are required to submit reservation through online system. Due to the limited number of dormitories, on-campus accommodation is not guaranteed. Exchange students will need to arrange for off-campus accommodation if application for on-campus accommodation is unsuccessful. ii) Private Accommodation	Students without a successful online reservation for on-campus accommodation is required to arrange for off-campus accommodation before arrival. Students may refer to the Information on the Off-Campus Accommodation at http://isc.sjtu.edu.cn/EN/content.aspx?info Ib=163&flag=3 In the neighborhood of Xuhui campus, the average rent for one-room lodging is 3,000 yuan per month. While around Minhang campus, the average rent will be around 2,000 yuan per month.
E. Visa	
Consular/Visa Regulation	Exchange students in China are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 day and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).
	You will receive the admission letter and visa application form (JW202 once you are accepted by the host university for the student exchange programme. Exchange students are required to apply for the student vision person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.
