ii) Curriculum Structure	Exchange students are required to take between 12 – 20 credits per semester. Requirements vary from Faculty to Faculty. 1 credit is equivalent to one course hour (45 minutes) per week.			
iii) Entry Requirements	 non-Chinese nationality (including Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macao passport holders) preferred; Chinese national applicants who have only studied outside of Mainland China are accepted but there is no provision of on-campus housing; be enrolled at the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a full-time student; have completed at least two semesters of study before embarking on the exchange programme; have a sound academic record, i.e. minimum GPA of 3.0, and should not have any grade below grade 'C' (grade point of 2.0) in any course; have sufficient financial means to cover the necessary expenses for the duration of the SEP (ranging from \$\$5,000 to \$\$15,000 per semester, subject to the country and local conditions at the overseas Partner University during the period of exchange). When applying for your student visa, a number of countries may demand documentary proof of your financial status; obtain the Faculty's approval for the SEP; satisfy partner institution and host country entry requirements; and check with the issuer of any scholarship he or she is receiving to ensure there are no restrictions involving overseas study (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education). 			
iv) Language Proficiency Requirements	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (with limited English-taught courses). NUS students with Chinese language background may be exempted from the HSK Chinese language proficiency requirements to read Chinese-taught courses at Tongji University.

University Accommodation	There are four dormitory buildings for international students located in three campuses (Siping, Zhangwu, Jiading campuses). Basically two students share one room and the cost. Each room is equipped with a toilet, shower and air-conditioner. Each floor has a public kitchen equipped with microwave oven and induction cooker. In addition, you can also use self-			

service laundry conveniently.

For exchange students nominated at the University-wide level, students will be guaranteed a twin-sharing room during the semester by Tongji University. This arrangement is not guaranteed over semester breaks. Please confirm with the service centre at the on-campus accommodation directly.

Exchange students are required to apply for the student visa in person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.

Tongji University requires exchange students to purchase a Comprehensive Insurance & Protection Scheme for Foreigners Staying in China recommended by the Ministry of Education during registration. The cost is RMB400 per semester, it basically covers the expenses for the medical treatments for accidental injury and hospitalization in public hospitals in the mainland of China.
