 i) Academic Calendar ii) Curriculum Structure 	Autumn Semester : September to January Spring Semester: February to July http://www.zju.edu.cn/english/19600/list.htm ZJU does not have any credit requirements for exchange students.
	Full-degree undergraduate students at ZJU are required to get a minimum of 15 credits per semester and a total of 169 credits during their 4-5 years study programme. 1 credit at ZJU is equivalent to 16 teaching hours.
iii) Entry Requirements	 Chinese nationality (including Hong Kong, Taiwan and Macao passport holders) are accepted but will follow a different application procedure (different to that of Non-Chinese passport holders) to be advised by ZJU; be enrolled at the National University of Singapore (NUS) as a full-time student; have completed at least two semesters of study before embarking on the exchange programme; have a sound academic record, i.e. minimum CAP of 3.0, and should not have any grade below grade 'C' (grade point of 2.0) in any module; have sufficient financial means to cover the necessary expenses for the duration of the SEP (ranging from S\$5,000 to S\$15,000 per semester, subject to the country and local conditions at the overseas Partner University during the period of exchange). When applying for your student visa, a number of countries may demand documentary proof of your financial status; obtain the Faculty's approval for the SEP; satisfy partner institution and host country entry requirements; and check with the issuer of any scholarship he or she is receiving to ensure there are no restrictions involving overseas study (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Ministry of Education).
iv) Language Proficiency Requirements	Mandarin is the medium of instruction for classes at the host university (with limited English modules). <u>Zhejiang University International Campus</u> in Haining (about 80km from ZJU main campus - Zijingang) offers more English-taught courses.

	ZJU does not require proof of Chinese language proficiency, however students who wish to read courses taught in Chinese are required to have very good command of Chinese language. For Chinese-taught courses in liberal arts and law, students should have the Chinese language proficiency equivalent to HSK 5 or above.

	Students who wish to apply for exchange at the ZJU International Campus are required to inform the home faculty's SEP coordinator (after acceptance of internal offer) in order to be nominated for exchange at the International Campus.
	The ZJU International Campus is located in the city of Haining and 80 km from the ZJU main campus (Zhijingang), students are not encouraged to combine courses from ZJU Main campus and ZJU International Campus.
vi) Module restrictions and pre-requisites	Students are required to have some basic knowledge or record of course learning for some advanced-level courses.
D. Accommodation	
University Accommodation	ZJU reserve on-campus accommodation for exchange students near the campus where student specialty college/department is located. The cost is approximately RMB1,500 per person per month on twin sharing basis. Exchange students are usually allowed to check-in within three days before the date of registration. A RMB800 refundable room deposit is required upon checking-in.

Consular/Visa Regulation	Exchange students in China are required to apply for student visa (X2 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of no more than 180 days and X1 visa for those intending to study in China for a period of more than 180 days).

Exchange students are required to apply for the student visa in person at the China Visa Application Service Centre in Singapore with the relevant documents before the start of the academic semester.
