GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT HOST UNIVERSITY

1	When does the semester begin/end?	<p>Semester 1 (Fall / Autumn) – September to February Semester 2 (Spring) – February to June</p> <p>Take note that final examinations may not be within the periods listed above.</p>
2	Which faculties or schools accept exchange students?	<p>Mines Paris is a graduate-level institution and is part of the wider Paris Science and Letters (PSL) University. Mines Paris offers courses in various STEM fields to NUS exchange students via its Master of Science and Executive Engineering Study Programme.</p> <p>Available fields (minors) include – Control Systems, Robotics, Vision & Morphology, Biotechnology, Process Engineering, Industrial Economics, Nuclear Engineering, Geosciences, Geostatistics and Applied Probability, Scientific Management, Design Engineering, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Public Affairs and Innovation, Machines and Energy, Information Systems and Computer Engineering, Material Sciences and Engineering, Underground Engineering and Management, Production Systems and Logistics.</p>
3	What modules can I read?	<p>Course catalogue for exchange students is available online at: https://catalogue.mines-paristech.fr/#cp=home</p> <p>Note that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modules available in the past might not be offered by the host university and/or approved by NUS for module mapping during the time of your SEP. • Courses not available to exchange students – Geology seminar, MIG. • Exchange students can select courses from the second year of the Master of Science in Executive Engineering or from selected Masters programmes offered by other units within the wider PSL organisation. Students selecting these programmes might have courses in other PSL institutions other than Mines Paris. • Students are not allowed to mix courses from different programmes, tracks or years.
4	What are the academic	<p>General Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed 3 years of study prior to participating in SEP at Mines Paris, i.e. be in Year 4 at the time of SEP.

	prerequisites and restrictions?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> English at B2 level; French at B1 level (to study courses taught in French). <p>It is important that you have the relevant academic background and meet the pre-requisites for the courses that you apply for. Academic workload is 30 ECTS per semester.</p>
5	What are the available options for student housing?	Exchange students can apply for a room at the “Cité internationale” or Crous residency through the PSL housing service, but there is no guarantee that a room will be assigned.
