1	When does the semester begin/end?	<p>Semester 1 (Fall / Autumn) – September to December Semester 2 (Spring) – January to May</p> <p>Take note that final examinations may not be within the periods listed above.</p>
2	Which faculties or schools accept exchange students?	<p>Exchange students can choose to visit one of Sciences Po's seven campuses, with the following most suitable for NUS students as they offer a larger number of courses in English:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paris • Le Havre • Menton • Poitiers • Reims <p>NUS students should indicate their preferred campus at the point of applying for your SEP.</p>
3	What modules can I read?	<p>An overview of the Sciences Po campuses and the courses offered at each campus is available at: https://www.sciencespo.fr/college/en/academics/exchange/</p> <p>Note that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modules available in the past might not be offered by the host university and/or approved by NUS for module mapping during the time of your SEP. • Under certain conditions, exchange students can obtain a Certificate of Studies in Social Sciences and Humanities. • Courses are offered in both French and English.
4	What are the academic prerequisites and restrictions?	<p>General Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed at least 2 years of study at NUS prior to SEP at Sciences Po. • Meet the relevant language requirements. <p>It is important that you have the relevant academic background and meet the pre-requisites for the courses that you apply for. Academic workload is 30 ECTS per semester.</p>
