Students are recommened to go to Telecom Paris in Year 4 in order to access the Master Year 2 courses offered in English.</li> <li>English at B2 level; French at B1 level (to study courses taught in French).</li> <li>It is important that you have the relevant academic background and meet the pre-requisites for the courses that you apply for. Academic workload is 30 ECTS per semester.</li> </ul>
