		Transfer and Accumulation System). The annual load of a UTC student amounts
		to 60 ECTS (i.e., approximately 12 CCs).
		Exchange students can select Core Programme and/or Major CC provided that
		these courses are actually taught during the semester concerned and that the
		selection is compatible with the university's timetable.
