

STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMME (SEP)

Information for Students on Exchange

A. University	Nagoya University
B. Country	Japan
C. Academic Calendar	Autumn Semester: Early October to early February Spring Semester: April to early August
D. Exchange Duration	One semester or two semesters (full year)
E. GPA Requirement	Minimum GPA of at least 3.0/4.0 scale (equivalent to NUS GPA 3.75/5.0)
F. Language Proficiency Requirement	Japanese language proficiency is not required if only taking courses taught in English. However, it is recommended that students have basic Japanese language knowledge. Students intending to take courses instructed in Japanese must submit an official certificate of JLPT Level N1.
G. Course Load	Minimum of 15 credits per semester
H. Accommodation	Nagoya University will apply for housing on exchange student’s behalf, which in principle, will be single rooms in student dormitories located either on-campus or within a short commute to the university. https://nupace.iee.nagoya-u.ac.jp/en/life/accommo.html
I. Visa	Nagoya University will apply for the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) on behalf of prospective exchange students once applications have been processed, and will send the COE directly to students via email. Students will then need to apply for a ‘Student’ visa at their local Japanese Embassy or Consulate with the COE, passport, and letter of admission. Students are also required to show their COE to the immigration authorities at the airport when they enter Japan.
J. Insurance	All full-time NUS students are covered under the university’s Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/ . It is compulsory for exchange students in Japan to join the National Health Insurance program. The insurance fee is around 1,500 JPY each month and you will only need to pay 30% of the medical costs when seeing doctors. It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within Japan. Please review your insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs.
