B. Country	Mexico
C. Academic Calendar	Semester 1 (Fall term): August – December Semester 2 (Spring term): February – June https://studyinmexico.tec.mx/how-apply/semester-calendar
D. Exchange Duration	One semester
E. Course Load	Each course is typically 3 credits, which encompass 48 class hours, 60 self-study and 15 supervised activity hours. A full academic workload is 18 credits (maximum credits students can enroll in).
F. Visa	<p>Exchange students who study for one semester only (180 days or less) are not required to apply for a student visa. However, depending on your country of citizenship, you may have to apply for a visitor visa to travel to Mexico.</p> <p>Singapore citizens do not require a visa to travel to Mexico for a period of entry not exceeding 180 days and for non-gainful activities (tourist).</p> <p>Please check your visa requirement and the latest advice on visa regulations from the Embassy of Mexico in Singapore. https://embamex.sre.gob.mx/singapur/index.php/consular-services/visas</p>
G. Insurance	<p>All full-time NUS students are covered under the university’s Student Group Personal Accident & Medical Insurance and the Student Travel Insurance. For more information on the university medical insurance, please refer to https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/.</p> <p>Tec de Monterrey requires all international students to have an international health insurance with specific coverages and amounts during their stay. SURA created a policy that covers and exceeds all the minimum requirements. Detailed information about the insurance and online purchase is available at: https://intercambioseguro.com/en/</p> <p>It is recommended that you purchase a comprehensive travel insurance for the full duration of your stay abroad, including your personal travel within/outside Mexico.
