


Syonan Shimbun 1943






Syed Syeikh Al-Hadi Collection

These newspapers, emerged during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries as a crucial channel of information in towns and major cities. This collection illuminates diverse and distinct regional attitudes, cultures, and vernaculars, providing an alternative viewpoint to the London-centric national press over a period of more than 200 years.


