1 To be considered for Nursing, Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Industrial Design, applicants must rank these programmes as first, second or third choice.

2 To be considered for Dentistry or Medicine, applicants must rank these programmes as first or second choice. If Dentistry or Medicine is ranked as second choice, the first choice needs to be an interview programme.

3 Applicants applying for Law should possess excellent polytechnic results, a minimum grade of A2 in English Language at 'O' Level and preferably a Certificate of Merit (COM) from their polytechnic studies. Applicants who have completed Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) or Institute of Education (ITE) programme prior to the diploma studies and do not fulfil the minimum GCE 'O' Level English requirement may still submit an application. They will be assessed based on their polytechnic results and other results/ certificates presented under the Achievements section. The University may evaluate these applicants on a case-by-case basis

To be considered for Law, applicants must rank Law as their first, second or third choice. If Law is ranked as the second choice or third choice, the programme choice(s) ranked above need to be an interview programme.

4 Applicants seeking admission to these programmes may be required to attend an assessment conducted by the relevant faculty. Shortlisted candidates will be informed if they are required to attend the assessment(s) for these programmes.
