

Standardised Test Requirements

This document details the minimum requirements for standardised test – [ACT](#), [AP](#) and [SAT](#).

Applicants with international qualification will be considered for admission based on one of the following:

- a) At least 5 AP courses; *or*
- b) ACT with Writing, and at least 3 AP courses; *or*
- c) SAT, and at least 3 AP courses

Note:

Three SAT subject Test subjects can be considered in lieu of AP courses.

Combination of section scores from different sittings is not accepted. • The validity of ACT scores is five years. • You may submit your ACT scores directly to the University or through ACT. Combination of scores from different sittings is not accepted. • The validity of SAT scores is five years. • You may submit your SAT scores directly to the University or through College Board. Our institution code is 3720. 	Application closing date applicable to your high school qualification.
SAT Subject Tests	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each Subject Test: 650 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SAT Subject Tests can be submitted in lieu of AP courses. • SAT Subject Tests taken between 2019 and 2021 will be accepted. 	Application closing date applicable to your high school qualification.
