4. To 'save' an incomplete form, your Identity Card/ Passport number, email and self-created PIN must be provided to enable the system to retrieve the form for your later completion/submission. Students who do not have any of the required information will not be able to save an incomplete application form, but have to start a new form to complete your application to the University.
5. You are encouraged to provide a valid Singapore mobile number to receive SMS alert for admission updates (e.g. shortlist notification for interview course and/or offer of admission).
