NUS College

NUS College (NUSC) is the Honours College of NUS. The College offers an enriched curriculum for undergraduates who wish to challenge themselves, both academically and beyond academics, while pursuing their degree in NUS. NUSC students will earn degrees conferred by their NUS degree programmes along with a certificate from NUSC.

Rigorous Interdisciplinary Curriculum

NUSC takes pride in advancing the frontiers of undergraduate education. NUSC courses are conducted in small groups of 20-25 students from different disciplines, with a special emphasis on critical thinking, global orientation, and impactful change-making in communities. NUSC courses replace most of the common curriculum courses required by the student's primary degree; the College also offers a large number of interdisciplinary electives and a team-based capstone project (Impact Experience, IEx).

Global Pathways

NUSC students are required to complete a Global Pathways requirement. Options include the NUSC flagship Global Experience courses, regional IEx projects, student exchange programmes, the NUSC summer international internship programme, and more.

Community

The NUSC community is an integral part of the learning and living environment for our students. All NUSC students are required to stay in the NUSC residential wings for two years, including the first year. The College also has a dedicated Growth Mentoring programme.

Admissions Information

NUSC is open to undergraduates from more than 60 majors across NUS. NUSC applicants will be assessed by NUSC for admissions into NUSC and the top-ranked choice of major that is compatible with NUSC. NUSC students can transfer between most majors after the first semester of enrolment, and within the first four semesters, with academic advice from NUSC. NUSC applicants are also considered concurrently by the respective degree-bearing faculties based on the selected choice of programmes, in the same way as other NUS applicants.
