- If fees are not paid or only partially paid by the due date (refer to [Office of Finance](#)), a late payment charge of \$25 may be imposed.
- The miscellaneous student fees are inclusive of prevailing GST and are payable per semester over the two semesters of an Academic Year. The prevailing GST is 9% with effect from 1st January 2024. For students admitted in Special Term and for current students who are not enrolled in Semester 2 but are taking course(s) in the Special Term, 50% of the normal semester charges will apply. This is regardless of whether the student chooses to do only one part of the Special Term or both parts.
- For conversion from full-time to part-time or vice versa, the Student Services Fee (SSF) payable for the semester is as follows:

For research students who have submitted their thesis, the Health Service Fee will be payable as long as the student remains full-time and has not been conferred the degree.

- Effective 5th August 2024, the University Health Scheme, which is currently available to full-time undergraduate students, will be extended to include all full-time graduate students. Graduate students matriculating in AY2024/2025 onwards will be subject to a new student health fee that reflects the enhanced primary healthcare benefits under the University Health Scheme. Existing graduate students who were admitted prior to AY2024/2025 will also receive the enhanced benefits without any change to their current student health fee. 8. All part-time students admitted from AY2026/2027 onwards will be charged a mandatory Health Service Fee (HSF). For AY2025/2026 intake and earlier, part-time students are not covered by NUS insurance and therefore are not required to pay the HSF.
