## Changes in Access to AISG Courses "AI4I® – Foundations in AI" and "AI4I® – Literacy in AI" with effect from AY2025/26

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Why will students no longer be able to gain DYOC course units through "Al4l® – Foundations in Al" and "Al4l® – Literacy in Al" from AY2025/26?

This is because AISG has recently announced that the complimentary one-year DataCamp subscription will no longer be available for the "AI4I® – Foundations in AI" course. Learners of this course will have to subscribe to DataCamp at their own cost from 1 Sep 2024 or whenever the complimentary coupons run out, whichever comes earlier, and NUS is unable to subsidise the DataCamp subscription.

Nevertheless, you can read the appropriate NUS courses to keep up with the essentials of machine learning and artificial intelligence.

2. When is the last date that I can submit my DYOC application, to be eligible for credit transfer for "Al4I® – Foundations in Al" and "Al4I® – Literacy in Al"?

The last date that any student can submit a DYOC application, to be eligible for credit transfer for completing the two Al4I courses, is the last day of the examination period for AY2024/25 Special Term Part 2, i.e., Saturday 2 August 2025, 2359 hours.

You must have successfully completed the two Al4I courses and obtained the certificates for the courses by the time of application.

Please be reminded that you are required to enroll in the Al4I course via AlSG's Al Student Outreach Programme in order to be eligible for credit transfer. Please note that students who have completed AI For Industry (AI4I)® are precluded from doing CS2109S Introduction to AI and Machine Learning, CS3244 Machine Learning, or IT3011 Introduction to Machine Learning and Applications.

3. What should I do if I was intending to use the 2 Al4I courses to fulfil my graduation requirement?

You should select alternative courses offered by NUS to fulfil your graduation requirement, or complete the two Al4I courses and submit your DYOC application for credit transfer by 2 August 2025.

4. What should I do if I complete the 2 Al4I courses while I am on Leave of Absence in AY2024/25 Semester 2, and I will only resume my studies in AY2025/26 Semester 1?

You should submit a DYOC application with both certificates for the courses by 2 August 2025, and we will process the credit transfer in the semester when you resume your studies in NUS. The credits for the two Al4I courses will be counted towards the semester that you resume your studies.

5. Can I read and complete the 2 Al4I courses before 2 August 2025, and submit my DYOC application for credit transfer after 2 August 2025?

No, you will not be eligible for credit transfer for the two Al4I courses after 2 August 2025.
