

Terms and Conditions

Your appointment is important to the University Health Centre (UHC). Please understand that when an appointment is missed, cancelled or changed without prior notice, this will result in missed opportunities for others to receive this service. Hence, please note that once you have scheduled a confirmed appointment, **your appointment is final**.

In adhering to current Safe Management Measures, please also note that this is **strictly by appointment** only. No walk-ins will be allowed.

This service is available only to all **current NUS Student, Staff and Dependents**. Your Student/ Staff card or In-Principle Approval (IPA) letter, Singapore Identification card (NRIC/FIN), Foreign Identification document (e.g. Passport/ID as stated on the vaccination certificate), printed copy of COVID-19 Vaccination documentation showing the dates taken for all doses, and confirmation of appointment is required at the point of registration.

You will be required to make a **payment of \$45 (inclusive of GST) at the clinic** on the day of your appointment and this is non-refundable.

Before making an appointment, please ensure you meet the following criteria:

1. You are a Singapore Citizen/ Singapore Permanent Resident/ Short-Term Pass Holders/ Long-Term Pass Holder (e.g. Long Term Visitor Pass, Work Permit, Employment Pass, S Pass, Student Pass and Dependent Pass holders). For Short-Term Pass Holders, this would only be relevant if you intend to stay in Singapore for more than 30 days.
2. You are fully vaccinated overseas with COVID-19 vaccines authorised by the Health Sciences Authority under the Pandemic Special Access Route (PSAR) or listed on the World Health Organization's Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL), namely:
 - a. AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - b. Coronavac COVID-19 Vaccine (Sinovac) Injection
 - c. Covaxin COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - d. Covishield COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - e. Covovax COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - f. Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - g. Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - h. Nuvaxovid COVID-19 Vaccine (Novavax) Injection
 - i. Pfizer-BioNTech/ Comirnaty COVID-19 Vaccine Injection
 - j. Sinopharm BIBP/WIBP COVID-19 Vaccine Injection

****Note**

1. UHC will update your COVID-19 records in National Immunisation Registry (NIR) only if your serology test result is positive. A negative serology result implies that you may not be protected

2. From 1 Jan 2022, Sinopharm and Sinovac-Coronavac vaccines will require three doses to be considered fully vaccinated:

- Persons with two doses will be considered vaccinated for a period of four months after 14 days of completing the two doses. The third dose needs to be completed from 90 days onwards for a person to be considered fully vaccinated.
- For persons who take the Sinopharm or Sinovac-Coronavac as part of a mixed primary vaccination series, at least three vaccine doses are required, including if the first or second vaccine were other WHO-EUL vaccines
- For recovered persons who had not completed a vaccination regimen, those vaccinating with the Sinovac-Coronavac or Sinopharm vaccine after recovery would require two doses vaccine doses.
