Some guidelines for noting:

- This event is open to current NUS staff, Emeritus Professors (EPs), Honorary Fellows (HFs), Emeritus Senior Administrators (ESAs) and their dependents (spouse and children* only), as well as current NUS students. *The capped age for children of staff (including EPs, HFs, ESAs, and contingent staff) is 25 years, as of birth date, at the time of screening. Important: Please also note the guidelines for participants under the age of 21, indicated below#.
- Current NUS staff with a valid NUS email address, and current NUS students with a valid NUS student matric number will be eligible for the health screening exercise.
- Please note that screenings are strictly by appointment only.
- Kindly note that eligible participants are entitled to one screening per year.
- On the day of screening, please present your appointment (via the Minmed Connect App) and your:
 - Staff Email (for current NUS staff, EPs, HFs, and ESAs)
 - Student Matric Card (for current NUS students)
 - Insurance e-Card or a photo of your spouse/parent's NUS Staff Card/NUS Email (for dependants of current NUS staff, EPs, HFs, and ESAs)
- It is recommended to observe the following timelines (where applicable) for your health screening:
 - One month after recovery from COVID-19
 - Two weeks after any vaccination administration
 - Six weeks after any vaccination (This is applicable for Mammogram/Breast Ultrasound screenings)
- If you are unwell or are experiencing any flu symptoms, kindly defer your appointment.

For participants below the age of 21 (Born in the Year 2006 and after) OR who would like to opt for only ala-carte onsite/offsite optional tests, kindly approach Minmed at <https://minmed.sg/contact-us/> to book an appointment or pre-screening consultation (applicable for individuals below the age of 21) at Minmed Health Screeners.
